

5 Note Scale - Violin

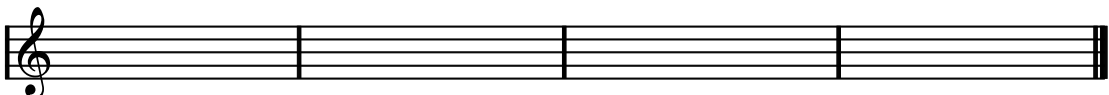
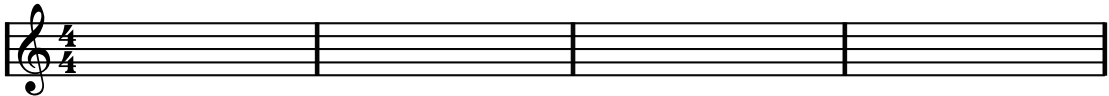
Practise playing this scale slowly



Perhaps you are thinking "But hang on - there are six notes in this scale!"
And you would be correct - but the first note and the last note are both 'D'.

It is very important to make certain that the first and third fingers are exactly in the right place and sound in tune. Try playing the scale with track # 40 on your backing CD.

Use a combination of crotchets, quavers and minims to compose a 12 bar melody using notes of the 5 note scale above - again, you can play this with track # 40 on your backing CD.
