

Tuning Your Guitar

Here is the instruction on tuning your guitar.

First of all, you need to tune the 'E' - 6th string or thickest string to another tuning note, such as a piano, or the tuning note on the backing CD.

Once you know that the 6th string is closely in tune, then:

Place a finger on the 5th fret of the 6th string - pluck it and then, pluck the 5th string
They should both sound the same - IF NOT, then adjust the peg for the 5th string until they sound the same

HINT: Do NOT turn a peg without plucking & listening to that string.



5th fret - 6th string

Place a finger on the 5th fret of the 5th string - pluck it and then, pluck the 4th string
They should both sound the same - IF NOT, then adjust the peg for the 4th string until they sound the same



Place a finger on the 5th fret of the 4th string - pluck it and then, pluck the 3rd string
They should both sound the same - IF NOT, then adjust the peg for the 3rd string until they sound the same



Place a finger on the 4th fret of the 3rd string - pluck it and then, pluck the 2nd string
They should both sound the same - IF NOT, then adjust the peg for the 2nd string until they sound the same



Place a finger on the 5th fret of the 2nd string - pluck it and then, pluck the 1st string
They should both sound the same - IF NOT, then adjust the peg for the 1st string until they sound the same
