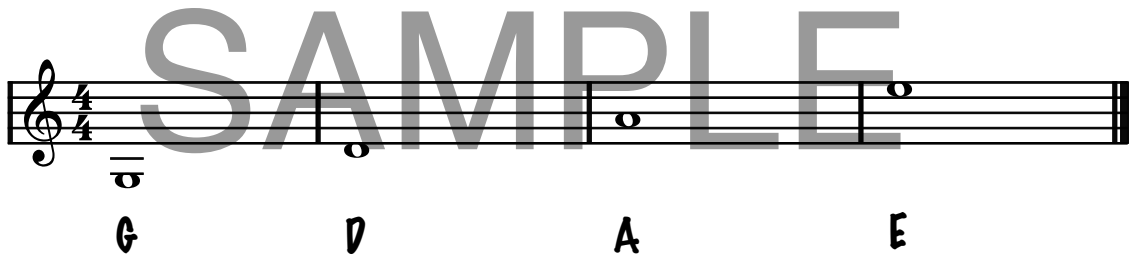




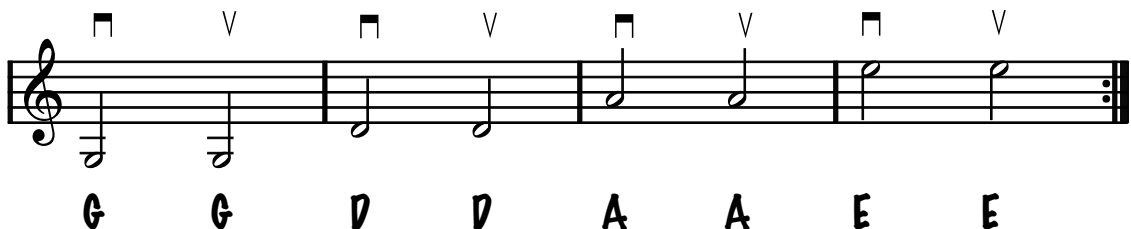
Introduction to the Violin

The open strings of the Violin are the notes we can make by simply moving the bow on the string without using any fingers in the left hand.



Play 2 pulses on each note - nice big bows - the symbols above the note indicate the direction the bow should go.

- Means to move the bow from the heel to the point.
- ∨ Means to move the bow from the point to the heel.



This line of open strings above is the very first track on the backing CD after the tuning note - play this exercise with the backing.

It repeats **TEN TIMES** on the backing CD. If you play this exercise **TEN TIMES** every day, then you will progress onto the next pieces very quickly.
